**Am** Then you listen to the music and you like to sing a long **E+** **Am7** **D**

**G** You want to get the meaning out of each and every song. **D** **Em7** **E7**

**Am** So you find yourself a message and some **E+**

**Am7** words to call your own and take them home **D** **E7**

## G-C-D G-C-D

**Em7** He can make you love, he can get you high **C**

**Em7** He will bring you down, then he'll make you cry **A**

**Cmaj7** Something keeps him movin' but no one seems to know **Bm7**

**Am7** Just what it is that makes him go **D**

**Am** Then the lights begin to flicker and the sound is getting dim **E+** **Am7** **D**

**G** The voice begins to falter and the crowds are getting thin **D** **Em7** **E7**

**Am** But he never seems to notice **E+**

**Am7** He's just got to find another place to play (x2) **D** **E7**
