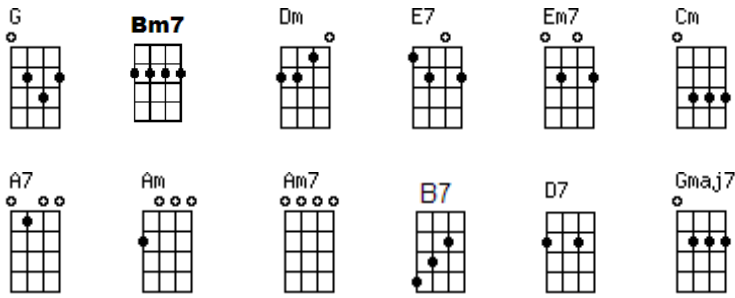


Tie a Yellow Ribbon 'Round the Old Oak Tree

Am **Cm** **Em7**

A7 **Cm** **D7**
 A simple yellow ribbon's what I need to set me free
Cm **D7**
 I wrote.....and told... her... please

G **Bm7**

Dm **E7** **Am**
 Now I've got to know what is and isn't mine
