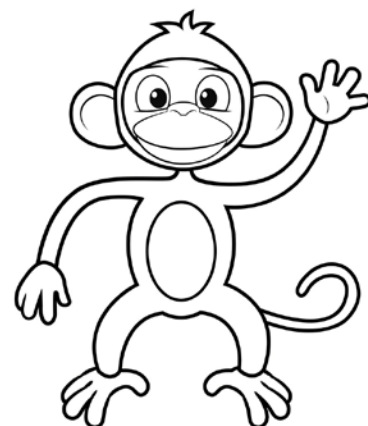
Roll 'em up and twist 'em up a high tuck a-haw
